

FAQ's for Legacy Memberships

As of December 4, 2016

What is a legacy membership?

The Legacy membership program has been established to allow members to provide easy access to Woods Club facilities to family members who are not otherwise included in a primary membership.

Who may I add to my membership as legacy members?

You may add family members who are direct ancestors or descendants (i.e., parents, grandparents, children, grandchildren, etc.) and their spouses. Stepfamily members may also be included. You may not add your siblings, cousins, nieces, nephews, friends, etc. You also may not add anyone who would be ineligible to use Woods Club facilities as your guest (i.e., non-member Woods residents). Unlike your membership, a legacy membership includes only one individual, not an entire family.

What classes of legacy membership are available?

Legacy members will be added to your membership and must, therefore, join the same class of membership. They may not upgrade to a higher class or downgrade to a lower class. For example, if you hold a Class B (Indoor/Outdoor) membership, a legacy member added to your membership may not upgrade to Class A (Indoor/Outdoor/Golf).

How much does it cost to become a legacy member?

The annual legacy fees for open classes of membership¹ are:

Class A (Indoor/Outdoor/Golf)	\$50/person
Class B (Indoor/Outdoor)	\$30/person

What are the benefits of legacy membership?

A legacy member is entitled to the same privileges as a primary member, except that legacy members may not establish charge accounts with The Woods Club.

¹ Per person legacy fees for closed classes are \$15 for Outdoor members, \$20 for Indoor/Outdoor/Weekday members and \$35 for Outdoor/Golf members.

Do legacy members need to be photographed?

Yes. To gain admittance to our facilities, each legacy member must be added to our database and must have a photograph taken at the Sports Center.

Are legacy members entitled to member discounts?

Yes. Current member discounts will be extended to legacy members. (Specific member discounts are subject to change.)

Can a legacy member purchase guest passes?

Yes. A legacy member can purchase guest passes under the same terms and conditions as a primary member.

Are there any additional membership privileges for Class A legacy members?

Yes. A Class A legacy member will enjoy the same privileges as the primary member when making starting times. In addition, Class A legacy members will be eligible for membership in the Woods Men's and Women's Golf Associations and participation in events sponsored by those organizations.

Can I authorize my family members to charge to my Woods Club account?

Yes. Although they may not set up their own account, you may authorize legacy members to charge to your member account. By doing so, you are agreeing to accept responsibility for all charges that result from their use of your account.

Can I add some family members now and add others later?

Yes. You may register some of your family members now and add others at a later date by completing a new registration form. However, the annual dues for legacy members who are added later on will not be prorated. Further, you may not transfer a legacy membership from one family member to another.

Who is responsible for paying the annual dues for a legacy membership?

As a primary member, it is your responsibility to register and pay the annual dues, plus tax, for any legacy member added to your membership. The Woods Club will not accept payments directly from individuals who are not already Woods Club members.

Does a legacy membership need to be continuous?

No. Unlike primary memberships, legacy memberships do not need to be continuous. You may choose to add an individual as a legacy member this year and not add them the following year. Doing so would not preclude you from adding them in subsequent years.

In the future, will I be billed for legacy members that I add to my membership this year?

Yes. Your annual dues invoice will include a separate, *optional* line item for the legacy members that have been added to your account. If you choose to renew legacy membership(s), the legacy payment(s) must be made in one installment, although annual dues for the primary membership may be made in two installments.

What is the deadline for paying dues for a legacy member?

There is no deadline. Legacy memberships may be established at any time. However, the annual dues for a legacy member will not be prorated and are not refundable if the primary membership is terminated during the membership year.

What will happen to legacy memberships in the event that I die?

Your membership will be transferred to the person or persons who acquire title to your property at The Woods. In the event that a property is inherited by multiple individuals, the membership must be designated to one person. Only that person's direct family members, as defined here, would then be eligible for legacy membership privileges. (Note that an auxiliary membership may be available for co-owners of the property.)

What will happen if I register someone who is not eligible for legacy membership as defined by this policy?

Registering an ineligible individual as a legacy member will constitute a violation of Woods Club policies and may result in the suspension or termination of your membership.

Will this program be available indefinitely?

We hope so. We believe that most of the individuals who will become legacy members are already regular guests at club facilities. However, we intend to monitor the use of our facilities and review the program annually to determine whether it has created any capacity issues or otherwise impacted the enjoyment of The Woods Club's facilities by its members.
